At a regular Board of Education meeting held at 8:30 a.m. on August 28, 2017, the Lisbon Board of Education approved a resolution to petition the Ogdensburg City School District Board of Education to allow Lisbon Central School boys to participate in interscholastic lacrosse at the boys modified and boys varsity level for the 2018-2019 season.

The merger resolution was moved by Andrea Randle, seconded by Chera Davison, and carried with five (5) yes votes and two (2) absent (Gendebien and Walker).

If this petition is approved, then all participating Lisbon Central School athletes will be required to abide by all Lisbon Central School academic eligibility rules and all rules and regulations covered in the student handbook for Lisbon Central School students.
