## POLICY

## SUBJECT: SPORTS AND THE ATHLETIC PROGRAM: SPORTS MERGERS

- 1. School administration shall not forward a request from another school district for a sports merger unless the following criteria are met:
  - a. The coach, Athletic Director and Superintendent of Schools support the request.
  - b. There shall be no additional cost to the Ogdensburg City School District for participation of students in another school district seeking to participate on an OFA sports team.
  - c. If a merger request is recommended for adoption it is understood that there shall be no cuts of OFA students by coaches within the sports program.
  - d. Playing time will still continue to be at the coach's professional discretion, based upon the skill level of the athlete. (Playing time will continue to be a non-negotiable item and will be determined at the coach's professional discretion, based upon their own team rules in conjunction with the Ogdensburg City School District Code of Conduct).
- 2. The Board of Education maintains the right to deny or accept a request for a sports merger.
- 3. Since the requesting district has to request a merger on a yearly basis, the Board of Education will review merger requests on a yearly basis to determine if it is in the best interest of the district for the merger to continue.
- 4. It is expected that a full, non-refundable payment of merger fees be received by the district prior to the start of the sports season.
- 5. The Board of Education reserves the right to assess a fee to a school district whose students play on an OFA athletic team. This will be based on the OFA billing formula for "merger students".
